Cedar Canyon 28 Federal Well No. 4 SWD

Dear Mr. Smith:

Reference is made to your request dated January 24, 2003 (received in this office February 7, 2003), to increase the surface injection pressure on the above referenced SWD well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on January 21, 2003. After reviewing test results, we feel an increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

This well is equipped with 2 7/8" coated tubing, injection packer, and top perforation at approximately 2950 feet – perforations in the Bell Canyon, and Upper and Middle Cherry Canyon. With size and type of tubing remaining the same, you are authorized to increase the surface injection pressure to the following:

Well and Location	Maximum Surface Injection Pressure
Cedar Canyon 28 Federal Well No. 4 SWD	900 PSIG Water
1980 FSL, 1980 FWL, Sec 28, T24S, R29E, NMPM, Eddy County	

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
