Reference is made to your application dated September 16, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location for Federal "B" Well No. 14 located 1152 feet from the North line and 420 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 27, Township 23 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Undesignated Lybrook Gallup Oil Pool, Sandoval County, New Mexico. The NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 27 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
