Reference is made to your application dated September 16, 1992 for a non-standard oil well location for Federal "B" Well No. 13 located 885 feet from the South line and 1158 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 22, Township 23 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Undesignated Lybrook Gallup Oil Pool, Sandoval County, New Mexico. The SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 22 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.
