Dear Mr. Hulse:

Reference is made to your application dated November 5, 1992 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 32-7 Unit Well No. 236 to be located 870 feet from the South line and 2008 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 28, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
