Dear Mr. Correa:

Reference is made to your application dated December 1, 1992 to drill three unorthodox gas well locations in an existing standard 642.52-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for the Eumont Gas Pool comprising all of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was originally dedicated to only the Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well No. 1 located at a standard gas well location 2310 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit J) of said Section 4.

By Division Order No. R-1103, dated December 18, 1957, an additional well, the Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well No. 2 located 2180 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 4 was approved for the subject GPU. Authorization was also given in said Order No. R-1103 to jointly dedicate Eumont Gas production from both the Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well Nos. 1 and 2 to the subject GPU provided production from the No. 2 well not exceed any more than 50% of the 640-acre unit's allowable for any six-month period.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described wells to be drilled at unorthodox gas well locations are hereby approved:

*Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well No. 3  
660' FSL - 1780' FWL (Unit N);*

*Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well No. 4  
1191' FNL - 674' FWL (Unit D); and,*


*Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well No. 5  
660' FSL - 960' FEL (Unit P).*

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Even though this order authorizes simultaneous dedication of the Eumont Gas production from the Eumont Gas Com No. 1 Well Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 to the subject GPU, all provisions of said Order No. R-1103 remain in full force and effect until further notice.
