Sport Environmental Services, on behalf of C. W. Trainer, submits the following Soil Investigation Results Summary as a result of potentially impacted soils sampling which took place on June 6, 2007 at the Harris Federal #1 Lease.

BACKGROUND

On April 26, 2007, Sport Environmental conducted visual contamination delineation with the use of a backhoe. Extensive sampling was not conducted at the time of the initial removal of visually contaminated soils. Soils which appeared to be visually contaminated were excavated and stockpiled in a soil-staging area which was built with a berm on a 20 mil liner located on-site. Initially, two stockpile areas were to be utilized for the subdividing of soils into those with heavy contamination and those with less contamination. Gross contamination was not encountered at the site resulting in the use of both soil-staging areas for visually contaminated soils of the same visual appearance. For safety purposes and until further delineation takes place, the open pit was fenced off upon completion of soils excavation.

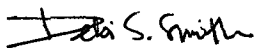
The NMOCD approved Sampling Plan dated May 10, 2007 was designed to verify a clean buffer perimeter and to address the potential of groundwater impact. The fate of the materials will be determined based upon analytical characteristics and NMOCD approval. Please refer to *Exhibit A* for the Soil Investigation Site Plan denoting the four (4) soil borings locations placed in the areas requiring

further vertical delineation. It is thought that shallow soil borings will provide ample analytical data to determine the extent of contamination and additional sampling needs. Analytical results associated with the June 6, 2007 sampling event can be found in *Exhibits B and C*.

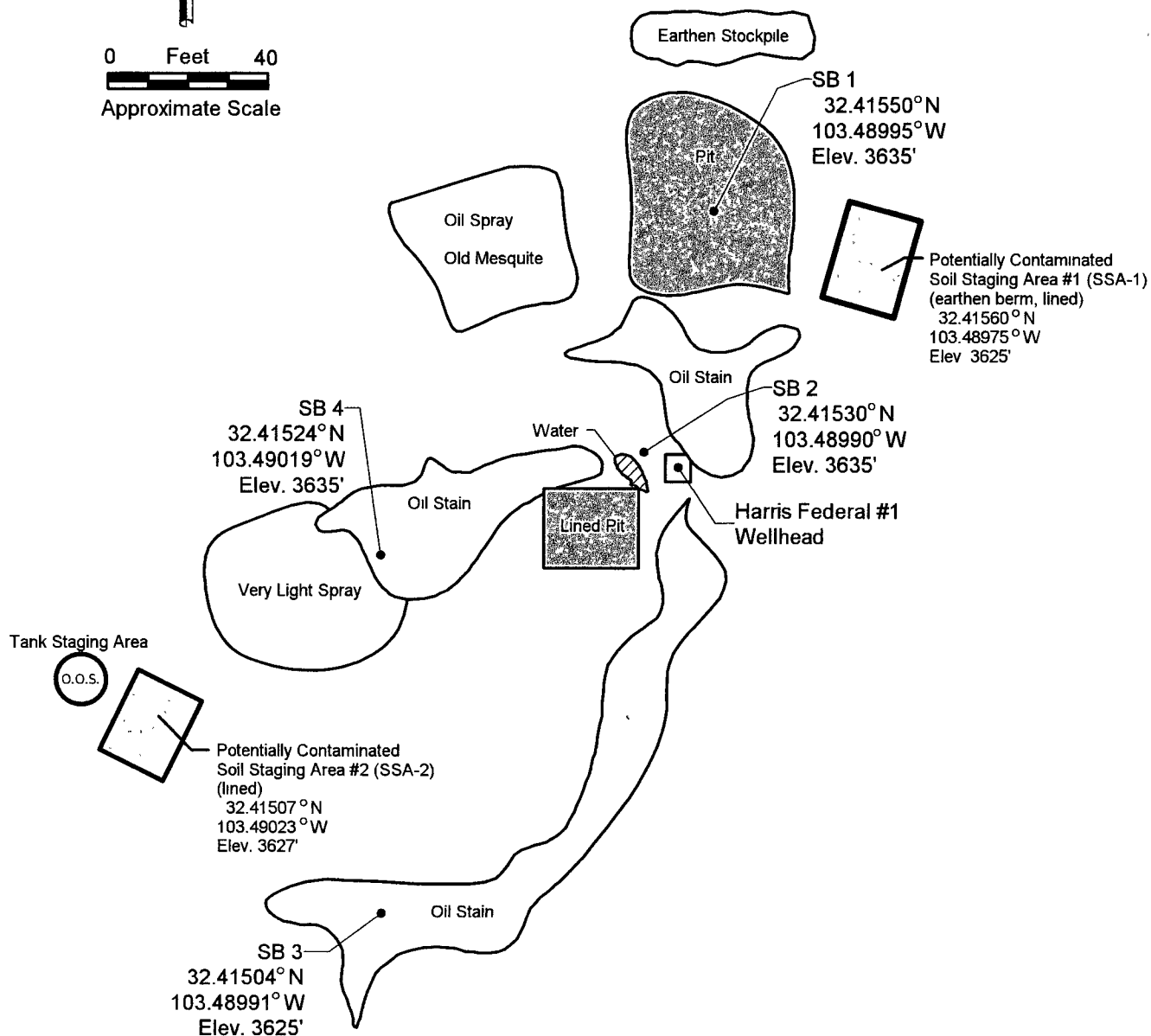

to the Harris Federal #1 wellhead



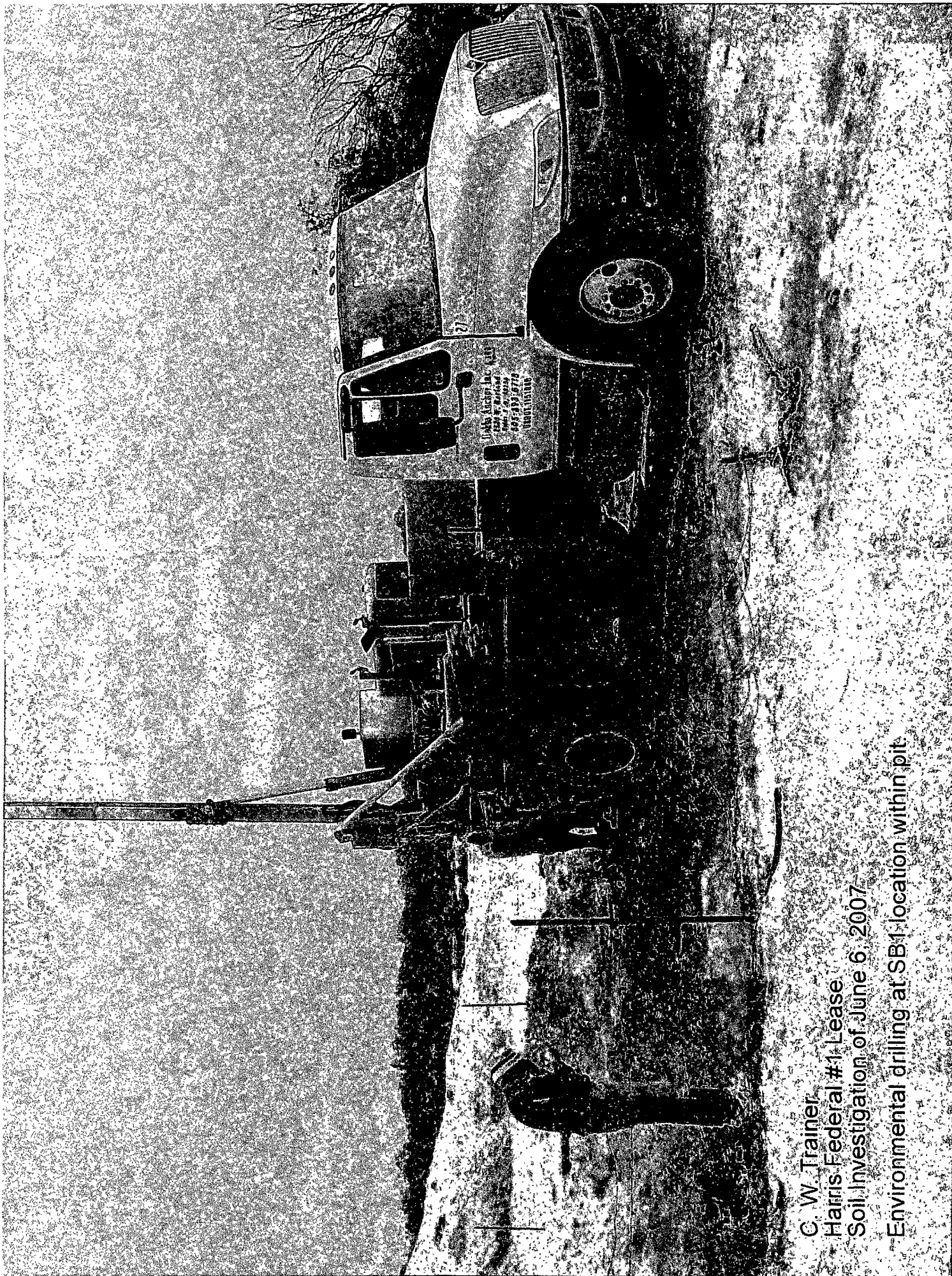

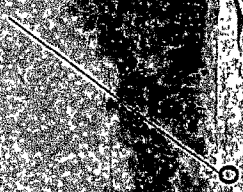

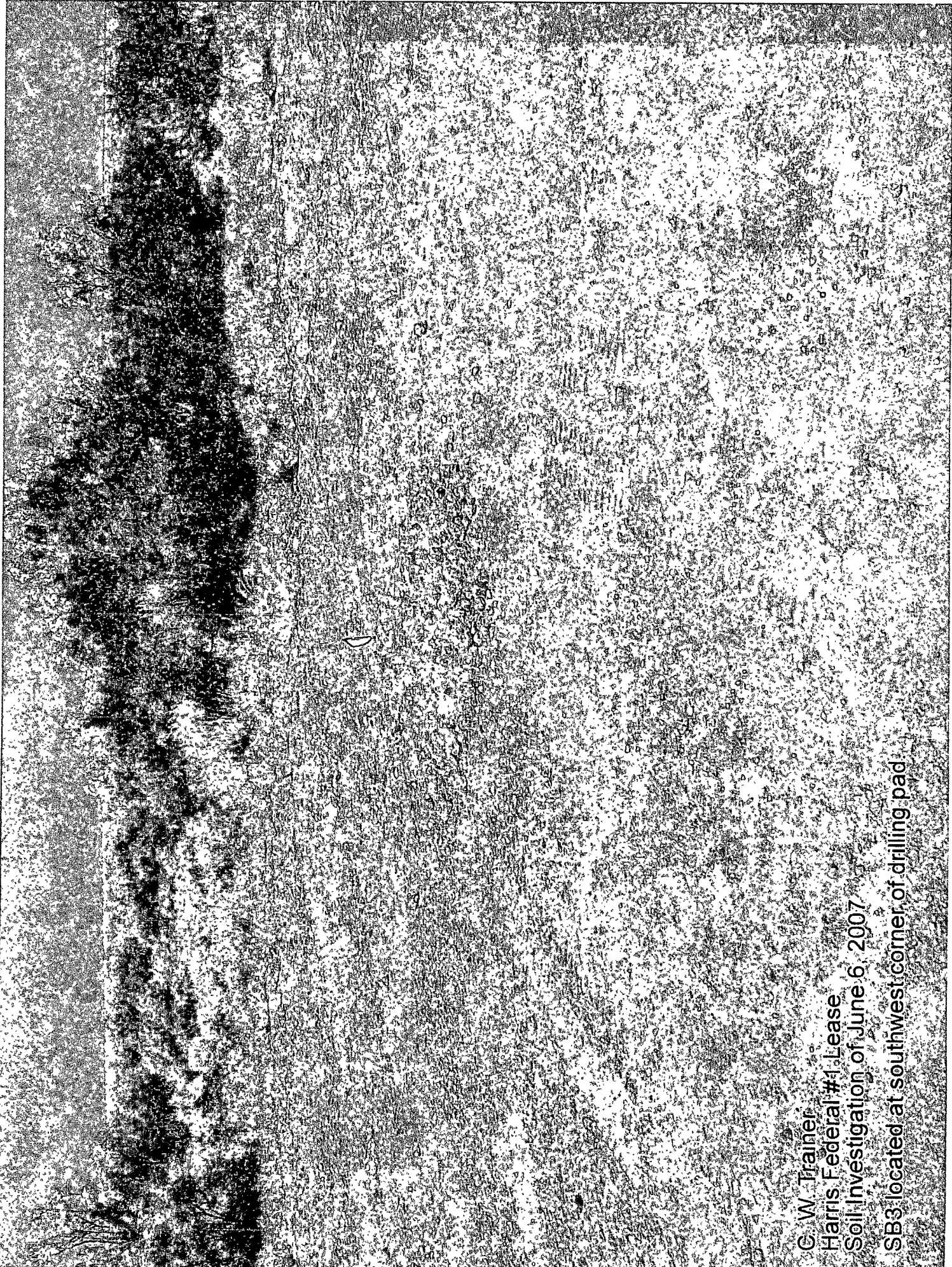

Environmental drilling at SB1 location within pit

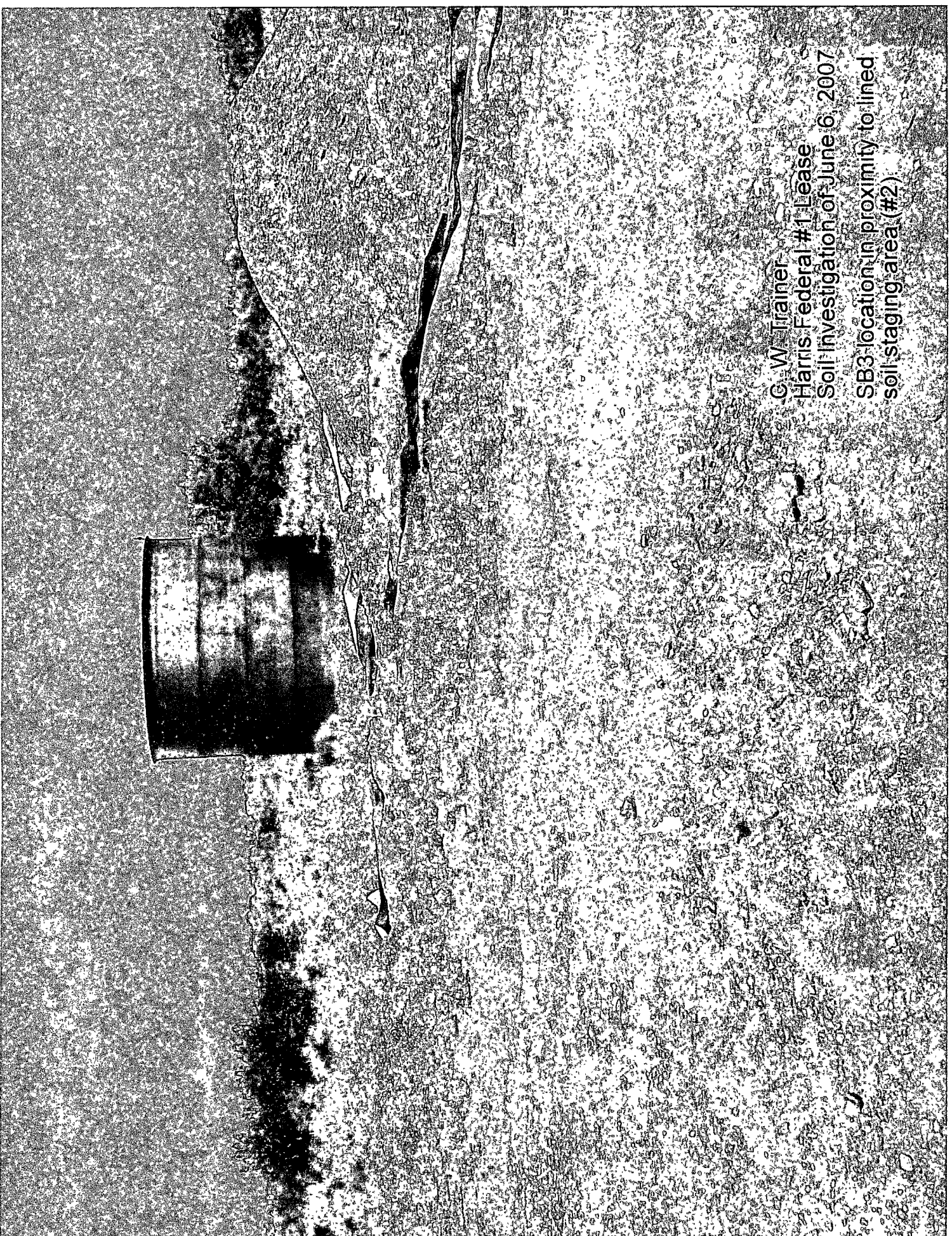

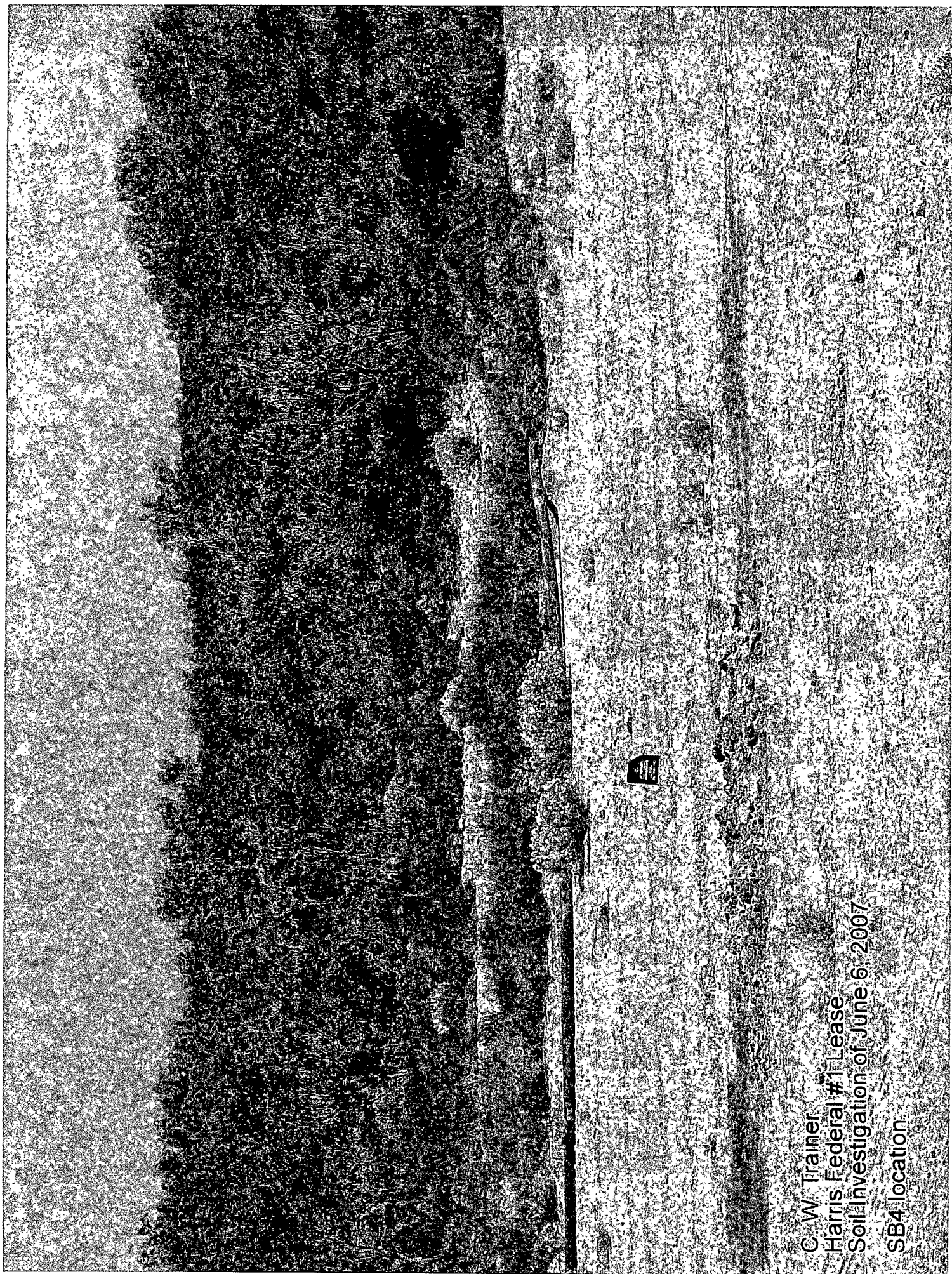
