Dear Mr. Jackson:

Reference is made to your application dated May 4, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an existing secondary recovery project for your West Red Lake Unit Well No. 37 to be located 1490 feet from the North line and 2050 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Red Lake-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, West Red Lake Waterflood Project Area (approved by Division Order No. R-3469, dated August 13, 1968), Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 7.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
