Reference is made to your application dated May 26, 1993 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Zapata Maljamar Waterflood Western State Project Area, established by Division Order Nos. R-2157 and R-2157-A.

It is our understanding that the proposed State 18-B Well No. 10 is to be drilled 1365 feet from the North line and 1260 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 18 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
