Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken. (If water spilled, give Chloride content)*
While working around DCPMs 4" pipeline, a contractor was using a bull dozer to build a pad for another company when the pipe was struck and a 1/2 half. Gas vented for approximately 3 hours and 15 minutes, until temporary repairs could be made to contain the release. Once contained, DCPM contracted a service company to cap the pipeline properly.

Describe Area Affected, Dimensions, and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The area of soil impacted was approximately 15 X 30. The contamination was on the surface only; therefore, affected area was scrapped with all soils placed on plastic until proper sampling could be conducted. Once approval is granted, the soil (approximately 5-7 yd3) will be disposed at the CRI land farm in Lea County, NM.
