Reference is made to your letters dated December 22, 1994 requesting administrative approval for two unorthodox oil well locations in Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Red Lake-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, West Red Lake Unit Area, West Red Lake Waterflood Project Area, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It appears that both proposed locations were previously approved by Division Administrative Order NSL-3296, dated August 23, 1993, as the West Red Lake Unit Well Nos. 39 and 40.
