## Dear Mr. Hulse:

Reference is made to your application dated August 5, 1993 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your San Juan 30-5 Unit No. 251 to be drilled 1378 feet from the South line and 273 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 25, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
