Amended Administrative Order NSL-3319

Dear Ms. Perrin:

Reference is made to your application dated February 24, 1994 requesting the amendment of Division Administrative Order NSL-3319, dated October 12, 1993, which authorized the unorthodox location of the Carracas Unit "PC" 34-B Well No. 6 to be drilled 1570 feet from the North line and 1950 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 34, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, to test the Pictured Cliffs formation, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding said well is to be drilled "1635 feet from the North line and 2055 feet from the West line (Unit F) of said Section 34," and that this change was necessitated by an archeological finding.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) Division Administrative Order NSL-3319 shall be amended to reflect said well location change. All other provisions shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
