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Re: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. to amend the pool designation in Administrative Order NSL-5721 which approved a non-standard location for EOG's Lusk "22" Federal Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-35590) 715 feet from the North line and 1130 feet from the West line of Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 23 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

EOG Resources, Inc. ("EOG") hereby seeks administrative approval to amend the pool designation in Administrative Order NSL-5721 which approved the non-standard location for the Lusk "22" Federal Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-35590) at 715 feet from the North line and 1130 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County New Mexico.

EOG re-completed this well in the Delaware formation and inadvertently indicated that the applicable pool was the Undesignated West Lusk-Delaware Pool (41540). EOG has been informed by the Division's district office that the correct pool is the North Lusk Delaware Pool (41545). Therefore, EOG requests that Order NSL-5721 be amended to reflect this well to be in the North Lusk Delaware Pool.
