Dear Mr. Wood:

Reference is made to your application dated January 7, 1994, for a non-standard oil well location for your Phoenix Well No. 1 to be drilled 240 feet from the South line and 1680 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 28, Township 27 North, Range 1 East, NMPM, to test both the Dakota and Entrada formations for oil, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Lot 3 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a non-standard 24.01-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rules 104.F(1) and 104.D(2), the above-described unorthodox oil well location and non-standard oil proration unit are hereby approved.
