Reference is made to your application dated February 28, 1994 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your existing San Juan 29-6 Well No. 257 (API No. 30-039-25015) located 981 feet from the South line and 2020 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 9, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 9 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
