Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated March 14, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for your Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 431 to be drilled 1475 feet from the North line and 1340 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin-Dakota Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 14 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
