APPLICATION OF YATES PETROLISM CORPORATION FOR PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ADVINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B). Yates Petroleum Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for permission to utilize for produced water disposal its proposed Jester SWD Well No. 4 (API No. 30-01/5-\_\_\_\_) located 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

## THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
  - (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

## <u>IT'IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:</u>

The applicant is hereby authorized to utilize its proposed Jester SWD Well No. 4 (API No. 30-015-\_\_\_\_) located 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of produced water for disposal purposes into the Bell Canyon and Upper Cherry Canyon members of the Delaware formation through perforations from approximately 3280 feet to approximately 4250 feet and through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located within 100 feet of the top of the injection interval.
