Dear Mr. Benson:

Reference is made to your application dated May 25, 1994 for a unorthodox infill gas well location in the Basin-Dakota Pool for the Rincon Unit Well No. 183-E to be drilled 1880 feet from the South line and 2080 feet from the East line (Unit J) of Section 31, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The existing gas spacing and proration unit comprising the S/2 equivalent of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well.

It is our understanding said well is to be dually completed with the Undesignated South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool in which the N/2 SE/4 equivalent of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well forming a 83.90-acre oil spacing and proration unit. The above-referenced well location is standard for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
