Dear Mr. Brown:

Reference is made to your application dated July 21, 1994 to re-enter the plugged and abandoned Durham, Inc. Shell Federal Com Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the North line and 2010 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, to test the Wolfcamp formation, Undesignated Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, and Undesignated Indian Basin-Strawn Gas Pool. Further, the applicant proposes to dedicate the E/2 of said Section 8 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both the Wolfcamp and Strawn intervals, or if applicable, all of said Section 8 to be dedicated to form a standard 640-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Undesignated Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool.

At this time, the applicant has made a proper filing pursuant to Division General Rule 104.F.(1) and Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, therefore the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
