
Lewis B. Burleson, Inc. requests administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit, and simultaneous dedication for its Lynn B-25 #5 well which is proposed to be completed in the Jalmat Gas Pool. We have notified by Certified Letter, all offset operators as shown in Exhibit "B" so that they may object to these variances within the specified waiting period.

Non-Standard Unit and Simultaneous Dedication:

A 320 acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit (S/2, Sect. 25, T-23-S, R-36-E) was previously approved for the Lynn B-25 #2 and #3 by Order R-2088 and amended by Order R-8170. We plan to re-complete the #5 well located 1980' FSL and 560' FWL, in Section 25 as a Jalmat Gas well, and simultaneously dedicate all three wells to the 320 acre unit. The Lynn B-25 #5 was drilled and completed by Flag-Redfern Oil Company in 1979 as a Langlie-Mattix producer. Upon approval, we plan to plug this well back to the Jalmat Gas Pool. The Upper Yates cannot be completed in the Lynn B-25#2 due to a slim-hole completion through a liner. This is why we wish to complete the Lynn B-25 #5 in the Upper Yates to protect our lease from drainage. It is our opinion a slant hole to the standard location 100' to the east would not be feasible.

This notice and all attachments are true and correct to the best of our knowledge and belief.

Dear Mr. Burleson:

Reference is made to your application dated December 15, 1994, for a non-standard Jalmat gas well location in an existing non-standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the S/2 of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order R-2088, dated October 13, 1961 and currently has dedicated thereon the Lynn "B-25" Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-09416), located at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of said Section 25.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox Jalmat gas well location is hereby approved:

*Lynn "B-25" Well No. 3
990' FSL - 1305' FEL (Unit P) of said Section 25*

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat gas production from the Lynn "B-25" Well No. 2 with the Lynn "B-25" Well No. 3. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from both wells in any proportion.

All provisions of said Division Order R-2088 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 4, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 13th day of October, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, seeks the establishment of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, comprising the S/2 of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, said unit to be dedicated to the Lynn B-25 Well No. 2, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of said Section 25.

(3) That the Lynn B-25 Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 of said Section 25 has been assigned to a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit, the total acreage of which is to be included in the proposed 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit.

(4) That the said Lynn B-25 Well No. 1 should be shut-in upon the establishment of the 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit and the production status of said well should be charged to said 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit.

(5) That the proposed 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit is presumed to be productive of gas from the Jalmat Gas Pool.

(6) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, comprising the S/2 of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established. Said unit is to be dedicated to the Lynn B-25 Well No. 2, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of said Section 25.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the Lynn B-25 Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 of said Section 25 shall be shut-in and the production status of said Lynn B-25 Well No. 1 shall be charged to the 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit.

(2) That the acreage factor for allowable purposes assigned to the above-described 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit shall bear the same ratio to a standard acreage factor as the acreage in said unit bears to the acreage in a standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

(3) That the effective date of this order shall be November 1, 1961.

(4) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on September 4, 1974, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 10th day of September, 1974, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, is the operator of a non-standard 320-acre gas proration unit comprising the S/2 of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, which is presently dedicated to applicant's Lynn B-25 Well No. 2, located in Unit M of said Section 25.

(3) That the producing capacity of said Well No. 2 has declined to the extent that it is incapable of producing the allowable for said unit.

(4) That the applicant is also the operator of its Lynn B-25 Well No. 1, located in Unit J of said Section 25, which well is capable of marginal production only.

(5) That the applicant seeks approval for the simultaneous dedication of the subject non-standard proration unit to its Lynn B-25 Wells Nos. 1 and 2 with the allowable assigned to said unit to be produced from said wells in any proportion.

(6) That approval of the subject application will better enable the applicant to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Jalmat Gas Pool and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That the applicant, Continental Oil Company, is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate its 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit, consisting of the S/2 of Section 25, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to its Lynn B-25 Wells Nos. 1 and 2, located in Units J and M, respectively, of said Section 25.

(2) That the allowable assigned to the above-described non-standard gas proration unit shall be based on the unit size of 320-acres and that the operator may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from the subject wells in any proportion.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.


