Reference is made to your application dated August 12, 1994, for a non-standard Jalmat gas well location in an existing non-standard 319.60-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Jalmat Gas Pool comprising Lots 1 through 4 and the S/2 N/2 (N/2 equivalent) of Section 1, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. R-2988, dated October 27, 1965, and had dedicated thereon the Vaughn "B-1" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-09487), located at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 1.

By Division Order No. R-4909, dated November 12, 1974, an additional well to be drilled and completed in the subject GPU was approved for the Vaughn "B-1" Well No. 6 (API No. 30-025-24844), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of said Section 1.

It is our understanding that the subject well to be considered in this application is currently a producing Langlie-Mattix oil well and upon issuance of this order will be recompleted up-hole into the Jalmat Gas Pool.

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By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox Jalmat gas well location is hereby approved:

Vaughn "B-1" Well No. 5 660' FN & WL (Lot No. 4/Unit D) of said Section 1 API No. 30-025-21656

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat gas production from the Vaughn "B-1" No. 5 with the two existing Vaughn "B-1" Well Nos. 1 and 6. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all three wells in any proportion.

All provisions of said Division Order Nos. R-2988 and R-4909 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
