Today, we received your letter to us of February 14, 1995 (copy enclosed). As was stated in our letter to Texaco dated February 10, 1995 (copy enclosed), we personally received (in Dallas), on February 10, 1995, Texaco's notification pertaining to its proposed J.R. Phillips No. 12 unorthodox Eumont well location. Although Texaco claims to have given us notice, on January 19, 1995, of its proposed J.R. Phillips No. 12, Texaco's notice was not sent to Dallas, Texas, where I reside and office.

During the latter part of 1994, we were involved in a lawsuit with Texaco and, at that time, Texaco was aware that I lived and officed in Dallas, Texas, since Dallas, Texas, is where Texaco took my deposition. The purpose of giving notification is to provide offsetting owner(s) with an adequate notice of a proposed oil and gas operation. When notice is not sent directly to an offsetting owner, it is difficult for that owner to immediately respond.

We believe that our letter to Texaco of February 10, 1995 is quite clear. We have stated that we are willing to waive objection to Texaco's proposed unorthodox J.R. Phillips No. 12 Eumont location providing that Texaco correspondingly is willing to act in the same reasonable manner if and when we perform additional Eumont development work on the offsetting 80-acre Britt A-6 lease consisting of the W/2 SW/4 Section 6, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Because of the infill drilling success that has been reported by Amerada in the Amerada-operated North Monument Grayburg-San Andres waterflood unit, we are presently formulating plans to drill a new Eunice-Monument well in the SW/4 SW/4 Section 6, T-20-S, R-37-E. Just as with Texaco's proposed recompletion of its J.R. Phillips No. 12 well, and so as to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, all that we are asking of Texaco is to have the ability, without objection from offset operators, to recomplete to the Eumont interval any newly drilled Eunice-Monument well that cannot be commercially completed as a Eunice-Monument producer.

If Texaco has a problem with the waiver terms that we have herein outlined, we are requesting that Texaco schedule a hearing before the NMOCD to show why it should be allowed to recomplete its J.R. Phillips No. 12 well to the Eumont interval while Doyle Hartman should not be granted an equal opportunity to do the same as to the offsetting 80-acre Britt A-6 lease consisting of the W/2 SW/4 Section 6, T-20-S, R-37-E in the event that we need to recomplete an existing Britt "A-6" wellbore to the Eumont interval.


We have received a copy of your conditional waiver to the proposed workover on the subject well.

We cannot accept the conditions set forth in your letter; specifically, that Texaco will waive objection to any future proposed drill or rework on unorthodox locations on your offsetting property. While we will not unreasonably withhold waivers on any work you may propose, we prefer to evaluate each well on a case-by-case basis. More lenient consideration will always be given to existing, legal wellbores made unorthodox due solely to recompletion, as is the case with our J.R. Phillips 12. Perhaps our original letter was unclear as to this fact; you mistakenly referred to it as a "newly proposed well location". Actually, the wellbore has existed since 1958.

Original notification of our intent to perform the workover on the subject well was received by you on January 19th. Having received no objections from offset operators, we are preparing to imminently commence operations. Unless we hear otherwise from you within five working days of receipt of this letter, your unconditional waiver will be assumed.



We have received a copy of your conditional waiver to the proposed workover on the subject well.

We cannot accept the conditions set forth in your letter; specifically, that Texaco will waive objection to any future proposed drill or rework on unorthodox locations on your offsetting property. While we will not unreasonably withhold waivers on any work you may propose, we prefer to evaluate each well on a case-by-case basis. More lenient consideration will always be given to existing, legal wellbores made unorthodox due solely to recompletion, as is the case with our J.R. Phillips 12. Perhaps our original letter was unclear as to this fact; you mistakenly referred to it as a "newly proposed well location". Actually, the wellbore has existed since 1958.

Original notification of our intent to perform the workover on the subject well was received by you on January 19th. Having received no objections from offset operators, we are preparing to imminently commence operations. Unless we hear otherwise from you within five working days of receipt of this letter, your unconditional waiver will be assumed.
