
Dear Mr. Wommack:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has been notified that Southwest Royalties is receiving fluids at an unpermitted surface evaporation pit located in Unit J, Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Southwest Royalties is hereby required to cease all operations at this facility until further notification from the OCD. In addition, Southwest Royalties is required to submit the following information to the OCD by February 21, 1994:

1. For all wastes disposed of at the facility supply the: origin, date of disposal, generator and transporter of the waste.
2. Any permits issued by the OCD or other agencies associated with the facility.
3. An analysis of the pond water for the following constituents: major cations/anions, dissolved hydrogen sulfide, total dissolved sulfides, and total volatile organics using EPA Method 601/602.
