The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of an Initial Report C-141 reporting a release of crude oil and produced water occurring at the above referenced facility. The C-141 (report) summarizes initial response actions taken. Additionally the report states soil samples will be obtained and presented to a laboratory to be analyzed for TPH and BTEX. Should the TPH and/or BTEX exceed the recommended remediation action levels, the report states that a work plan will be submitted to OCD.

- Notify the OCD 48 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses are to be submitted to the OCD.
- Remediation work plan (as warranted per soil analytical data) to be submitted to OCD on before June 27, 2008.
- Results of analytical data obtained through sampling shall be forwarded to OCD for approval prior to any backfilling activities
- A final Report C-141 is to be submitted to the OCD upon satisfactory completion of remediation project.
- Remediation requirements may be subject to change as site conditions warrant.
- Remediation activities including submitting Final Report C-141 and documentation to be completed/submitted on or before July 25, 2008.
