Reference is made to your application dated October 17, 1995 for a non-standard oil well location for your proposed Jackson "B" Well No. 37 (API No. 30-015-28641) to be drilled 2400 feet from the South line and 567 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson (Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 24 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(1), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
