Reference is made to your application date December 6, 1995 for an unorthodox coal gas well location for the proposed McConnell Well No. 500 to be drilled 1780 feet from the North line and 2180 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 13 shall be dedicated to said well to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
