Dear Ms. Logan:

Reference is made to your application dated March 13, 1996 for a non-standard oil well location for the proposed Gold Rush "30" Federal Well No. 4 (**API No. 30-015-28872**) to be drilled 2500 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Undesignated Nash Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico. The NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 30 is to be dedicated to said well to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996.
