Reference is made to your application dated March 19, 1996 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Turner "A" (Lease) Grayburg-Jackson Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3185, as amended by Order Nos. R-3185-A, R-3528, and R-3528-A.

It is our understanding that the proposed Turner "A" Well No. 48 (API No. 30-015-28869) is to be drilled 2350 feet from the North line and 1330 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Said well is to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 NW/4 of said Section 19, which is currently dedicated to the Turner "A" Well No. 22 (API No. 30-015-05247), located at a standard oil well location 2310 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 19.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104.F(2) of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
