

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The flowline coming out of the treater leaked. There was no standing fluids on the ground, immediate remediation was done.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An area just north of the battery approx. 140' X 40' was affected. 2 foot of the ground was remediated, where TPH and BTEX samples were shown to be below the limits per OCD approval. A drilling rig was brought in to drill bore holes to determine where the chloride limit was. The depth of the chlorides showed to be below 250ppm @ 65" bgs. Approval was given from the OCD to line the area with a 12 mil. liner and backfill the area with clean topsoil.
