Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The area affected was the "F" Pipeline right of way (two tracker road). The approximate size of the affected area is approximately 2' wide x 60' long x 4" deep. All effected soils will be tested for TPH and BTEX (process knowledge constituents of DCPM pipeline), remediated, and hauled to an NMOCD approved disposal site. After all contaminated soil is removed; this location will be backfilled with soil approved by the NMOCD. C1-Cue
