



Weatherford International, Inc., 515 Post Oak Blvd., Houston, TX 77027 has submitted an application to the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Oil Conservation Division for a new discharge plan permit (GW-373) for their Hobbs Fishing & Rental Facility, located in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 21, Township 18S, Range 38E, in Lea County, New Mexico. The physical address of the facility is 3217 Enterprise Drive, Hobbs, New Mexico. The facility is located approximately 6 miles west of Seminole Draw, an intermittent stream.

The facility rents and services oil field tools needed for the exploration and production of oil and natural gas. Materials generated or used at the facility used lubrication oil, gear oil and oily waste water from servicing and washing equipment. Approximately 400 gallons of wash down water are treated daily in an aboveground treatment system equipped with a mechanical oil separator and biological filters and discharged to the Hobbs sanitary sewer system. Oil is mechanically separated from the wash water and collected for recycling along with the used lubrication oil. Approximately 1000 gallons of oil, and 160,000 gallons of wash water is generated at the facility during the year. All liquids utilized at the facility are stored in dedicated above ground storage tanks prior to offsite disposal or recycling at an OCD approved site. All storage tanks are within properly engineered and OCD approved secondary containments. The aquifer most likely to be affected is approximately 60 feet in depth, and the total dissolved solids concentration of this aquifer is approximately 1300 mg/l.



## NOTIFICACIÓN PÚBLICA

Weatherford International, Inc., 515 Post Oak Blvd., Houston, TX 77027 presentó una solicitud al Departamento de Energía, Minerales y Recursos Naturales de Nuevo México, División de Conservación de Petróleo para obtener un nuevo permiso de plan de descarga (GW-373) para su instalación Hobbs Fishing & Rental, ubicada en el NW/4 del SW/4 de la Sección 21, Township (Municipio) 18S, Range (Terreno) 38E, en Lea County, Nuevo México. La dirección física de la instalación es 3217 Enterprise Drive, Hobbs, New Mexico. La instalación se encuentra ubicada a aproximadamente 6 millas al oeste de Seminole Draw, un arroyo intermitente.

La instalación alquila y realiza revisiones de herramientas utilizadas en yacimientos petrolíferos necesarias para la exploración y producción de petróleo y gas natural. Los materiales generados o utilizados en la instalación utilizan aceite lubricante, aceite para engranajes y aguas residuales de productos provenientes de equipos de mantenimiento y lavado. Se tratan aproximadamente 400 galones de agua procedente de lavado en forma diaria mediante un sistema de tratamiento aéreo equipado con un separador mecánico de petróleo y filtros biológicos con descarga al sistema del drenaje sanitario de Hobbs. El petróleo se separa mecánicamente del agua procedente del lavado y se recolecta para reciclado junto con el aceite lubricante utilizado. Se generan aproximadamente 1000 galones de petróleo y 160,000 galones de agua de lavado en la instalación durante todo el año. Todos los líquidos utilizados en la instalación se almacenan en tanques de almacenamiento especializado que se encuentran por encima de la superficie, previamente al desecho o reciclado externo a la planta en un sitio aprobado por la División de Conservación del Petróleo (OCD, por sus siglas en inglés). Todos los tanques de almacenamiento se encuentran dentro de contenedores secundarios, sometidos a procesos adecuados de ingeniería y aprobados por la OCD. El acuífero que tiene más probabilidades de verse afectado se encuentra a aproximadamente 60 pies de profundidad, y la concentración total de sólidos disueltos correspondiente al acuífero es de aproximadamente 1300 mg/l.


