

The facility rents and services oil field tools needed for the exploration and production of oil and natural gas. Materials generated or used at the facility used lubrication oil; gear oil and oily waste water from servicing and washing equipment. Approximately 400 gallons of wash down water are treated daily in an aboveground treatment system equipped with a mechanical oil separator and biological filters and discharged to the Hobbs sanitary sewer system. Oil is mechanically separated from the wash water and collected for recycling along with the used lubrication oil. Approximately 1000 gallons of oil, and 160,000 gallons of wash water is generated at the facility during the year. All liquids utilized at the facility are stored in dedicated above ground storage tanks prior to offsite disposal or recycling at an OCD approved site.
