Administrative Order NSL-3874-A

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated February 16, 1998 requesting the amendment of a previously approved order by the Division of an unorthodox Blanco-Mesaverde gas well location by expanding the vertical limits of the provisions in said order to include the deeper Basin-Dakota Pool.

Division Administrative Order NSL-3874, dated September 20, 1997, authorized Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company to drill its San Juan "30-6" Unit Well No. 43-A at an unorthodox infill gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool 2280 feet from the South line and 1130 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, within an existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") comprising the E/2 of said Section 14.

It is our understanding that Burlington now intends to drill to the Basin-Dakota Pool and dually complete said well, and, pursuant to Rule 2(b)1 of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, said location is also considered to be unorthodox. The E/2 of said Section 14 is also to be dedicated to said well in order to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of said special pool rules for the Basin-Dakota Pool the above-described unorthodox gas well location for the San Juan "30-6" Unit Well No. 43-A is hereby approved.

All provisions of said Administrative Order NSL-3874 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.

Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
