Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated May 9, 1998, which was received by the Division in Santa Fe on May 12, 1998, for an unorthodox gas well location in both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools for the proposed San Juan "30-6" Unit Well No. 11-A to be drilled 640 feet from the North line and 510 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 23, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool comprising the W/2 of said Section 23, which is presently dedicated to Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company's San Juan "30-6" Unit Well No. 11 (API No. 30-039-07793), located at a standard gas well location 1450 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 23 and the W/2 of said Section 23, being a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin Dakota Pool, is to be dedicated to said well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "*General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool/Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location for the San Juan "30-6" Unit Well No. 11-A is hereby approved.
