Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated May 9, 1998 for an unorthodox Blanco-Mesaverde "infill" gas well location on an existing standard 301.86-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for said Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, comprising Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, and 14 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 24, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. Said GPU is currently dedicated to the San Juan "32-9" Unit Well No. 68 (API No. 30-045-11316), located at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the South and West lines (Lot 13/Unit M) of said Section 24.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of **Rule 2(d)** of the "*General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox "infill" gas well location in said Section 24 is hereby approved:

**San Juan "32-9" Unit Well No. 68-A  
1205' FNL - 1705' FWL (Lot 3/Unit C)**

Further, both the San Juan "32-9" Unit Well Nos. 68 and 68-A are to be dedicated to the subject 301.86-acre GPU. Said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico.
