

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated May 9, 1998 for Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company to drill its San Juan "28-5" Unit Well No. 107 at an unorthodox gas well location within the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool 1600 feet from the South line and 255 feet from the West line (Lot 4/Unit L) of irregular Section 12, Township 28 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. All of said Section 12 is to be dedicated to said well in order to form a standard 299.04-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "*General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
