This well was recently drilled as a confidential well under Rule 1105. It has been plugged back and completed as temporarily abandoned, however we still lack some reports that are now delinquent, such as the spud notice and other sundry reports. The completion report and attachments are supposed to be held confidential from the public for 90 days from the date of completion, which in this case would be the date of the pressure test for TA approval. The completion report and attachments are not due for 20 days from that date however it is difficult to tell what that date is from the incomplete information we have received.

Thanks for bringing this to our attention and we will pursue this with the operator to get the documents up to date.

I will send you the plugback/TA report in another e-mail right away. Except for the APD and the NIT, this is all we have.
