PUBLIC NOTICE

Enterprise Products Operating, LLC P. O. Box 4324, Houston, TX 77210-4324, has submitted an application to the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Oil Conservation Division for a renewal of the previously approved discharge plan (GW-186) for the Kutz #2 Compressor Station. This facility is located in the SE/4 of the SW/4, Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 12 West in San Juan County, NM; approximately 1.25 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 64 and County Road 3500, then west on County Road 350 one-tenth mile, then south on County Road 5569 for .75 of a mile to facility on the right. The location of the facility is Latitude N 36.7266466 Longitude W -108.0864949. Questions concerning this application may be directed to Mr. Jon Fields at the Houston address.

The facility provides compression, storage, and distribution of oil and gas related materials. Materials generated or used at the facility include pipeline condensate and field liquids, new and used compressor lubrication oil, and oily wastewater from engine or scrubber wash down. Approximately 280 barrels/year of field liquids, 40-50 gallons/engine/annually of used motor oil and 180 barrels/year oily wastewater is generated at the facility. All liquids utilized at the facility are stored in dedicated storage tanks prior to offsite recycling or disposal at an OCD approved site. All storage tanks are within properly engineered and OCD approved secondary containments. No onsite discharges are intentionally allowed to contact or enter surface or groundwater. The aquifer most likely to be affected is 30 to 75 feet in depth, and the total dissolved solids concentration of this aquifer is estimated to be between 774 ppm to 3270 ppm..

Box 4324, Houston, TX 77210-4324, ha sometido una solicitud a la New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Oil Conservation Division para la renovación del previamente aprobado plan de descarga de residuos (GW-186) para la Kutz #2 Compressor Station. Esta planta esta localizada en el SE/4 del SW/4, Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 12 West en el Condado San Juan, NM; aproximadamente 1.25 millas al norte del cruce de la Autopista 64 y el Camino del Condado 3500, luego al oeste en el Camino del Condado 350 un decimo de milla, luego al sur en el Camino del Condado 5569 por 0.75 millas hasta la planta a la derecha. La ubicación de la planta es Latitud N 36.7266466 Longitud W - 108.0864949. Preguntas acerca de ésta solicitud pueden ser dirigidas a Mr. Jon Fields en la dirección en Houston.

Esta planta proporciona compresión, almacenaje y distribución de materiales relacionados con gas y petróleo crudo. Materiales generados o utilizados en la planta incluyen condensación de gases y líquidos dentro de las tuberías, aceite de lubricación nuevo y usado de los compresores, desperdicio de agua aceitosa de los motores o agua de lavado del scrubber. Aproximadamente 280 barriles/año de líquidos de las tuberías, 40-50 galones/motor/ año de aceite usado de los motores y 180 barriles/año de desperdicio de agua aceitosa son generados en la planta. Todos los líquidos utilizados en la planta son almacenados en tanques antes de ser reciclados fuera de la planta o de la eliminación en una planta aprobada por la OCD. Todos los tanques están localizados en retenciones secundarias apropiadamente diseñadas o aprobadas por la OCD. Descargas de la planta no son intencionalmente permitidas que entren o estén en contacto con aguas superficiales o subterráneas. El manto acuífero con mayor probabilidad de ser afectado es de 30 a 75 pies de profundidad, y la concentración total de sólidos disueltos en este manto acuífero es estimada de ser entre 774 ppm a 3270 ppm.

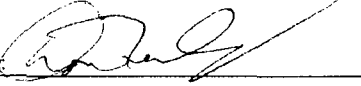
