Reference is made to your request dated October 3, 2003, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Cruces Well No. 3, which is located within the Phillips Cruces Lease Waterflood Project, Lynch Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. This request is based on step rate test conducted on the well on September 30, 2003. The data has been reviewed by my staff and we feel an increase in injection pressure on this well is justified at this time.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:
