Dear Mr. Prather:

Reference is made to your application dated May 28, 1998 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for Phillips Petroleum Company's proposed San Juan "32" Federal 28 Well No. 1 to be drilled 432 feet from the South line and 783 feet from the West line (Lot 13/Unit M) of Section 28, Township 32 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, and 14 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 28 are to be dedicated to the well in order to form a standard 317.78-acre gas spacing and proration unit for this pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
