Marathon Oil Company ("Applicant") is hereby authorized to transport off-lease hydrocarbon liquids produced from those wells (with associated acreage and producing pools), listed in detail on the Applicant's Exhibit #2. For each well listed on Exhibit #2, the producing pool approved by this Order shall be that pool actually producing at this date for that well, notwithstanding those pools actually listed on Exhibit #2.


The new storage point for liquids shall be the Marathon Oil Company Central Facility located in Unit D, Section 1, Township 21 South, Range 23 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

In addition, all commingled liquid storage points approved previously by Division Orders PLC-124C, PLC-144A, PLC-175A, CTB-482A, and CTB-484, are hereby superseded by this order. The portions of these previously issued Orders not in conflict with this Order are still in force and effect. Separate and accurate measurement of hydrocarbons is still required for each "lease" as defined in Rule 303.B.(2)(a).

The Applicant shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of this off lease storage.

Approval is also required from the Bureau of Land Management and the State Land Office.
