

Dear Mr. Sharpe:

Reference is made to your application dated October 28, 1998 for an off-pattern non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your proposed Shank Com. Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-29516) to be drilled 1840 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of Section 2, Township 26 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 3 and 4, the S/2 NW/4, and the SW/4 of Section 2 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 319.96-acre gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
