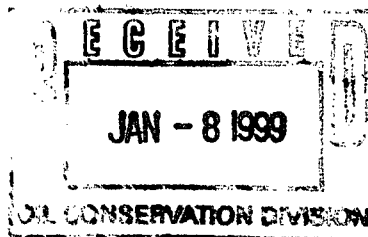

Pursuant to Division Rule 104.F(2), Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. ("Santa Fe") applies for administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the following well:

Rio Blanco "4" Fed. Com. Well No. 2  
660 feet FSL & 660 feet FWL  
S½ §4, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM  
Lea County, New Mexico


Santa Fe plans to drill the well to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation (Undesignated Antelope Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool). Well spacing is 320 acres, with wells to be no closer than 1650 feet to the end line and 660 feet to the side line of the unit. See Order No. R-3050. An APD and Form C-102 for the well are being prepared, and will be submitted to the Division as soon as they are available.

The proposed location is based on geologic reasons. Attached as Exhibit A is an isopach of the Upper Morrow Grama Ridge "A" Sand, the main Morrow pay zone in this area. Other Morrow penetrations in this area are noted on the map. The Morrow is a northwest-southeast trending channel sand, and the Morrow thickens as you move to the west in the well unit. Placing the well at the proposed location will enable Santa Fe to penetrate approximately 10-15 feet of Morrow pay, which Santa Fe believes is necessary for a commercial well. Santa Fe's Rio Blanco "4" Fed. Com. Well No. 1, in the SE¼NW¼ of Section 4, encountered substantially less than 10 feet of sand. Thus, the location substantially reduces the risk involved in drilling the well.

Attached as Exhibit B is a land plat of the area, highlighting Santa Fe-operated acreage in yellow. The affected offset acreage (Sections 5 and 8) is in the Bell Lake Unit, operated by Conoco Inc.<sup>1</sup> Santa Fe has also notified the lessee to the south, Phillips Petroleum Company, and the operator of the W½ of Section 9, Southwestern Energy Production Company, although the proposed well is not encroaching to the south. The notice letter to the offsets is attached as Exhibit C.
