Gentlemen:

In reviewing the above designated Communitization and examining the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission file concerning this Communitization, it appears that under letter of June 3, 1955, the Oil Conservation Commission rejected your request for a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, and they state that your Hale Well No. 1 was completed within the vertical limits of the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool.

Therefore, unless you have completed or contemplate drilling a well in the Jalmat, we feel that this Communitization should be terminated, as the State Land Office approval was subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

We therefore request that you show cause why we should not terminate this Communitization.
