Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator of a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the SW/4 of Section 30, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's Sunshine Well No. 2 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 30. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas proration unit was filed, and by your Administrative Order No. NSP 172, you approved the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in accordance with the pool rules based upon a unit of 160 acres.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of the leasehold interest covering Lot 4 in the E/2 SW/4 of Section 30 and Sinclair Oil and Gas Company is the owner of the leasehold interest covering Lot 3 of Section 30. Gulf and Sinclair have agreed to pool their respective interests for the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Eumont Gas Pool and the Pooling Agreement is in the process of preparation for execution.

Pursuant to the practice heretofore followed by the Commission, you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas proration schedule, effective immediately, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 160 acre unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the SW/4 of Section 30, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of a State oil and gas lease known as its Sunshine Lease located in the E/2 of the SW/4 and SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 30, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Sinclair Oil and Gas Company is owner and operator of a State lease known as its State 193 Lease located in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 30, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Gulf and Sinclair leases comprise the 160 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of the Sunshine #2 located 1980 feet from the west line and 660 feet from the south line of Section 30, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was plugged back to a depth of 3624 feet from the Eunice Oil Pool, the well was then completed in the interval of 3310 feet to 3522 feet in the Eumont Gas Pool on June 28, 1955.
- (3) Contingent upon obtaining Oil Conservation Commission approval of this application for the non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit, Gulf Oil Corporation and Sinclair Oil and Gas Company have agreed to enter into a gas pooling agreement and an operating agreement covering the above described 160 acres for the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eumont Pool gas under the acreage and have agreed to use the Gulf Oil Corporation Sunshine #2 as the Unit Well.

- (4) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
- (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
 - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation and Sinclair Oil and Gas Company to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.


