operator and granting another unless policy change is made--further if
simultaneous acreage is granted to every operator it may prove to be equitable
in the final analysis. This is a complicated problem.---S. J. S.

Gentlemen:

Comes now Cities Service Oil Company and respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission approve a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit, embracing the SW/4, Sec. 4-19S-37E, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support of the application wishes to state the following:

1. The Cities Service Oil Company's State "AT" No. 1, located 660' from the South line, and 660' from the West line, Sec. 4-19S-37E, has been completed as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. A request for gas allowable was submitted June 29, 1955.
2. The producing horizon is the Queen formation, through perforations from 3608-24, 3660-78, 3704-24, 3746-64, 3808-18, 3853-65.
3. The State "AT" No. 1 meets all spacing requirements of Order R-520 for assignment of a non-standard 160 acre gas proration unit.
4. A plat is attached showing the above described lands.
5. All operators in Section 4, and within 1500' of the State "AT" No. 1, have been notified by registered mail of our intention to form this non-standard gas proration unit.

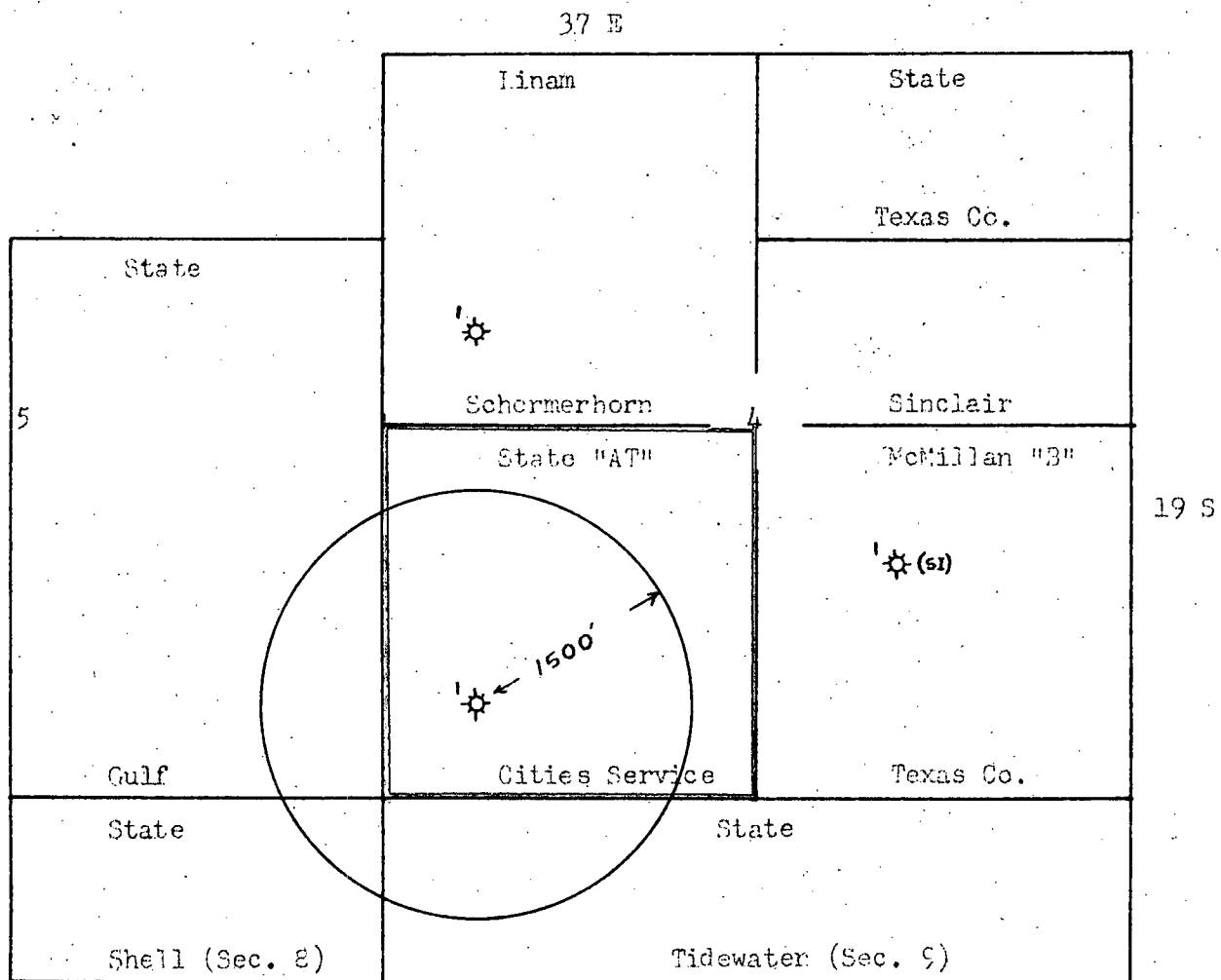
