Gentlemen:

Administrative Order NSP-211 issued March 2, 1956 is amended to read as follows:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NNPM
SE/4 of Section 12

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your G. W. Toby Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the South and East lines and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NNPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
