Re: Application to Dually Complete and to establish a 80 acre Nonstandard Proration Unit in the Tubb Gas Pool for Sinclair's J. R. Cone "A" Well No. 1 in Section 26-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company wishes to make this application for administrative approval under Order R-316, Rule 112A, to dually complete their J. R. Cone "A" Well No. 1 in the Tubb Gas Pool and the Drinkard Oil Pool (present zone).

Sinclair also wishes to make application for administrative approval under Order R-586 for a Nonstandard Proration Unit consisting of 80 acres and located in the W/2 of the SW/4 of Section 26-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico to be assigned to subject well.

In the above matters Sinclair wishes to state:

1. Sinclair Oil & Gas Company is the operator of the J. R. Cone "A" No. 1 Well which is located in the center of the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 26-21S-37E. This well was completed as an oil well in the Drinkard Oil Pool on October 29, 1946 at a total depth of 6,555 feet. Five and one-half inch casing was set at total depth and cemented with 350 sacks and perforated in the Drinkard Oil zone from 6180 to 6540 feet.
2. Sinclair proposes to dually complete subject well in the following manner:
 - a. Perforate the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing from approximately 6020 feet to 6245 feet in the Tubb Gas Pool.
 - b. Set a production packer below the Tubb perforations at about 6300 feet to separate the two pay zones.
 - c. Produce the Tubb gas through the casing-tubing annulus and the Drinkard oil through the tubing.

3. Sinclair will comply with all the rules and regulations of the Commission applicable to dual completions and the separation of pay zones.
4. Sinclair believes that the manner and method of this proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
5. The Nonstandard Gas Proration Unit to be assigned subject well consists of two contiguous quarter-quarter sections and is described as the W/2 of the SW/4 of Section 26-21S-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located 660 feet from the West and South lines of the Unit. The length or width of this unit does not exceed 2,640 feet and it lies wholly within a single governmental quarter section. The royalty interests and the leasehold interests are common under the unit. Subject unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas from the Tubb Gas Pool.

Sinclair believes that the granting of this application is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

Sinclair has notified all offset operators as defined in Orders R-316 and R-586 of this application by copy thereof via registered mail. Said operators are listed on next page.

Sinclair, therefore, requests that this application, both for permission to dually complete and for the establishment of an 80 acre Nonstandard Proration Unit in the Tubb Gas Pool be granted by the Commission.

Schematic Sketch

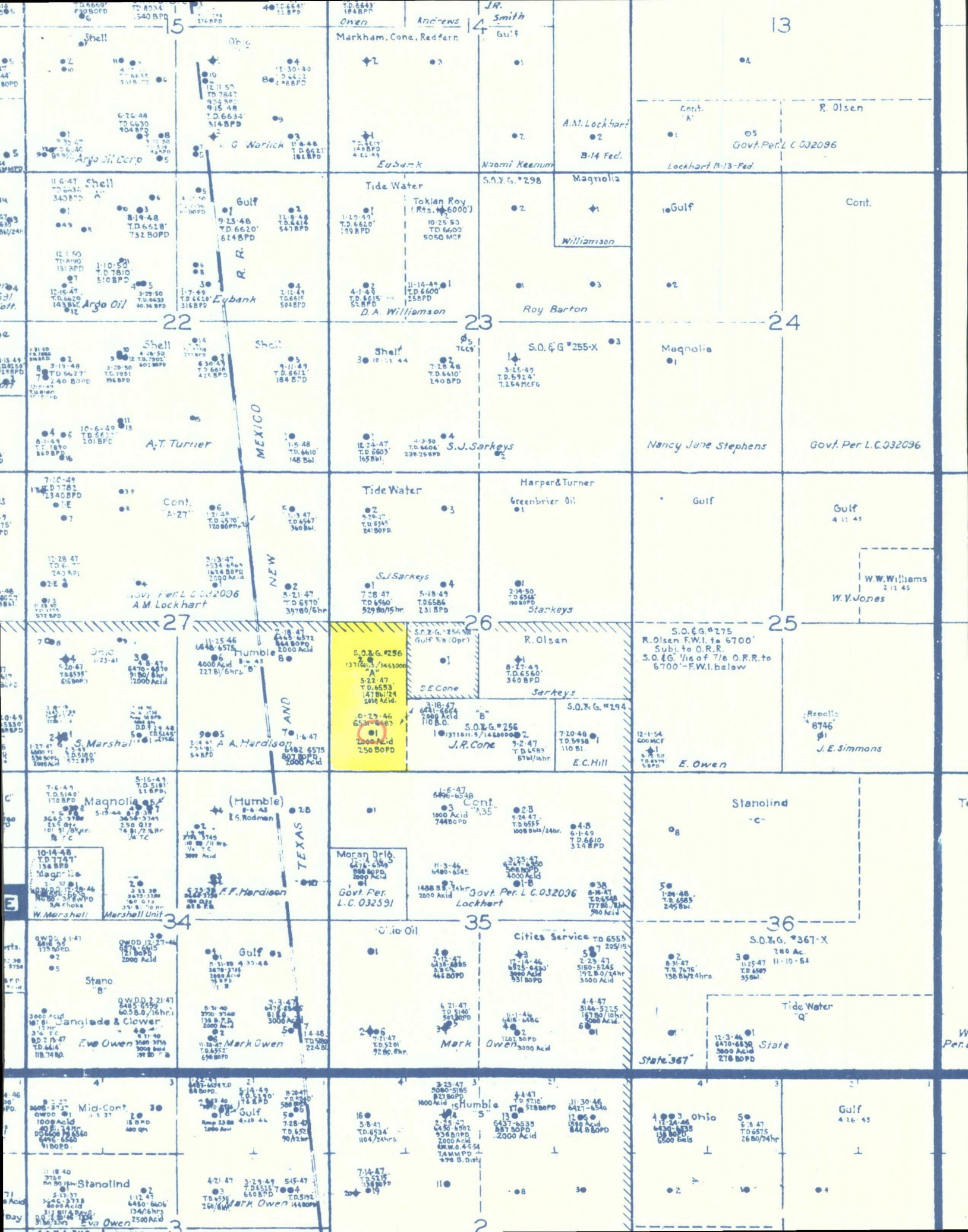
