Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-520 for a 240acre non-standard gas proration unit for its Meyer A-18 No. 4 well located 1980 feet from the North and East lines of Section 18, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- There are no operators other than applicant owning interests in the section in which the proposed non-standard unit is situated or within 1,500 feet of the well to which the proposed unit is to be allocated.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset owner ship.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission enter an order approving the nonNew Mexico Oil Conservation Commission

standard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's Meyer A-18 No. 4 well as described above.


