Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM  
NE/2 SW/4 and SE/4 of Section 18

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Saunders-State "K" Unit Well No. 1, located 760 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line and in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 18, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), Section 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres. The allowable shall be effective the first of the month following the receipt of an affidavit from you indicating the consummation of the communitization agreement of the royalty working interests. This notification shall be sent to our Hobbs office with a copy to the Santa Fe office.
